The Christmas Eve Christ Candle

- **One:** The Advent time of waiting and preparing is over! We -1have lit four candles that remind us about waiting in hope and peace and joy and love. (*Light the four Advent candles.*)
- **Two:** These candles remind us that God promises to be with us, to comfort us, to help us rejoice, and to teach us to love.
- **Three:** This evening we celebrate that God has come to be with us in the baby called Jesus.
- **Four:** Today we light one more candle, and we call it the Christ candle. *(Light the central white candle.)* This candle reminds us of all God has done for us.
- **Five:** God fills us with good things, like hope and peace and joy and love. God is faithful to us. God is with us, now and always.
- All: O God, come, lead us through our lives. Give us courage to spread your light in the world. Amen.

Loving God, you are the guardian of the poor. Many children are being born tonight in places no better than that stable in Bethlehem. We pray for them.

Pause 2.

For Christ is born of Mary, and gathered all above, while mortals sleep, the angels keep, their watch of wondering love.15 O morning stars together proclaim the holy birth, and praises bring to God the King, and peace to all on earth. God of comfort, we thank you that we have a warm place to gather, and friends and family to care for us. We pray for all who are sick, lonely, in trouble, or afraid, that they may be healed and comforted.

Pause 3.

How silently, how silently, the wondrous gift is given. So God imparts to human hearts the blessed gift of heaven. No ear may hear his coming, but in this world of sin, where meek souls will receive him, still the dear Christ enters in. God among us, in the birth of Jesus you show us your hope for the world.
