

Communion Servers Procedure.

1. The servers go to the back of the church during the offering. They bring the elements and the dishes to the front and place them on the Communion Table, and then sit on chairs behind the communion table. They should bring their bulletin and hymn book with them.
2. The communion presider will give each pair of servers a plate of bread and a bowl of juice. The servers will serve the choir first, then the congregation.
3. After serving the congregation, the servers will serve each other – one set of servers should place the bread and juice back on the communion table. They will be served by the other servers who will then pass the juice and bread to the other servers, who will then serve the other servers. Following this the plate with bread and the bowl with juice are returned to the communion table.
4. Return to your seats behind the communion table. You may return to your seats during the singing of the final hymn.
